



Code of Conduct – Coaches.

In order to maintain a positive environment for all to thrive in within the club, it is important that coaches are made aware of the coaches' code of conduct, which should be adhered to wholly. Anyone failing to meet behaviour standard will be dealt with at the discretion of Edge Club Officials.

- Do not abuse or misuse any relationship of trust or position of power or influence.
- Hold paramount the safety and wellbeing of all club members.
- Respect the dignity, worth and wellbeing and safety of every person within the club.
- Be respectful at all times, regardless of ability, cultural background, religion, gender or any other protected characteristic.
- Conform to the standards for conduct, behaviour, equality, etiquette and good manners specified in British Gymnastics regulations or policies in accordance with accepted traditions of gymnastics, and if necessary, report any incident, referrals or disclosures immediately and in accordance with British Gymnastics Safeguarding and Protecting Children Policies.
- Report any conflicts as soon as you become aware of them.
- Ensure that confidential information is not divulged unless with the express permission of the individual involved.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance, dressing suitably in club attire and using appropriate language at all times whilst involved in club activities.
- Ensure that you hold any required qualification appropriate to the role you are undertaking and ensure that you do not coach outside of that qualification unless undertaking an official mentoring session.
- Attend appropriate and updated training or meetings as required to ensure that roles are up to date with policies, procedures and any changes within the club.
- Bullying or bullying behaviour will not be tolerated and will be dealt with at the discretion of the Head Coach and Child Protection Officer.
