



## Code of Conduct – Volunteer.

In order to maintain a positive environment for all to thrive in within the club, it is important that volunteers are made aware of the volunteers' code of conduct, which should be adhered to wholly.

- Do not abuse or misuse any relationship of trust or position of power or influence.
- Hold paramount the safety and wellbeing of all club members.
- Be respectful at all times, regardless of ability, cultural background, religion, gender or any other protected characteristic.
- Be aware of and report conflicts as soon as they arise.
- Ensure that confidential information is not divulged unless with the express permission of the individual involved.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance, dressing suitably in club attire and using appropriate language at all times whilst involved in club activities.
- Attend appropriate and updated training to ensure that roles are up to date with policies, procedures and any changes within the club.
- Ensure you always work within your current qualification or underneath a mentor.
- Bullying or bullying behaviour will not be tolerated and will be dealt with at the discretion of the Head Coach and Child Welfare Officer.
